Draft National Planning Policy Framework

It seems that the most important housing need is for affordable homes. It also seems that we should protect our ability to feed ourselves. By making a 'presumption in favour of sustainable development' (whatever sustainable really means!) the Government will achieve the opposite. Only minor fractions of the numbers of houses that developers deliver are affordable, because they don't make enough profit, and it's easier to develop on green fields. The Government should scrap these plans, return to a presumption in favour of using brownfield sites, and create better incentives for developers and local councils to build affordable houses rather than executive mansions.
